Education and Experience

Josie Bouchier earned her Master of Science in Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine from the Colorado School of Traditional Chinese Medicine in August 2008. This four-year program consists of 3,000 hours of education including 1,000 hours of clinical practice. She was certified as a Diplomate in Oriental Medicine by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) in September 2008. This includes certification in Clean Needle Technique and Chinese Herbology.

Josie's training includes adjunctive therapies such as moxibustion (heat therapy), tui na (Chinese massage), gua sha (friction therapy), acupressure, cupping, auriculotherapy, and dietary and lifestyle recommendations. Josie has also completed the NCCAOM approved Treatment of Infertility Course with world renown Doctor of Chinese Medicine, teacher, and author, Jane Lyttleton in February 2014.

Josie is a licensed Acupuncturist in Colorado. None of her licenses, certificates or registrations has ever been suspended or revoked.

This clinic complies with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, including the proper cleaning and sterilization of needles and the sanitation of acupuncture offices. Only single-use, disposable, factory-sterilized needles are utilized.
